Law & Democracy Milestones

There was cause for celebration when Books For Africa's Jack Mason Law & Democracy Initiative delivered its 100th law library in a shipment to the Supreme Court of Namibia through the support of strategic partner Thompson Reuters! To mark the occasion, BFA joined former Minneapolis Mayor and Thomson Reuters VP for Government Relations and Strategic Partnerships, Sharon Sayles Belton, and other friends and partners of both BFA and Thomson Reuters. Former U.S. Vice President Walter Mondale wrote a congratulatory letter for the occasion, noting that providing law books "has a transformative impact well beyond the classroom or courtroom, strengthening the rule of law and improving the lives of thousands of people and their communities."



African Union Partnership

Books For Africa announced a formal partnership with the African Union in 2019, and BFA leadership attended the 2019 African Union Summit in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. Her Excellency Afrikan Chinombori-Quao, African Union Ambassador to the U.S., agreed to serve as Co-Chair of the Jack Mason Law & Democracy Initiative, a position previously held by the late former U.N. Secretary General Kofi Annan. Ambassador Chinombori-Quao and BFA Summit Society Chair, His Excellency Dr. Ngosa Simbyakula, Ambassador of Malawi to the U.S., co-hosted our annual Summit Society reception at the African Union Mission in Washington D.C., where they were joined by a large contingent from the African Diplomatic Corps.
